I Construction Products Regulation (CPR;305/2011/EU)

Harmonised rules for *marketing* of construction products

- Not directly regulating their use
- For marketing, unitary & comprehensive

Focus on **performance** of products: within **DoP**



II Common technical language

Means for assessing performance

• in relation to essential characteristics

Harmonised technical specifications

- standards (hEN)
- more individualised solutions (EOTA)



III Essential characteristics & BWR

Performance related to essential characteristics

= Aspects which have a bearing for the demands to be set for construction works (buildings, roads, bridges ...)

Hence, **BWRs** (basic requirements for construction works)

BWR 7 : Environmental sustainability



IV BWR 7 & hENs

hENs not yet incorporating BWR 7

First standardisation request adopted by COM and accepted by CEN

First hENs expected by the end of this year / early next year



V EPDs

Based on EN 15804

Covering roughly the same field as BWR 7

= While could be used as a base for the respective parts of the DoPs, integration into the CPR comprises this information into them
